King Edward VII often visited the Jameson family at their beachside home and on his last official visit to Ireland in 1907, he unveiled a plaque which was designed especially to celebrate the marriage between members of two great distilling families, Jameson and Haig, back in 1788.

The plaque stands in the Secret South Garden of the hotel grounds.
