LOCATION

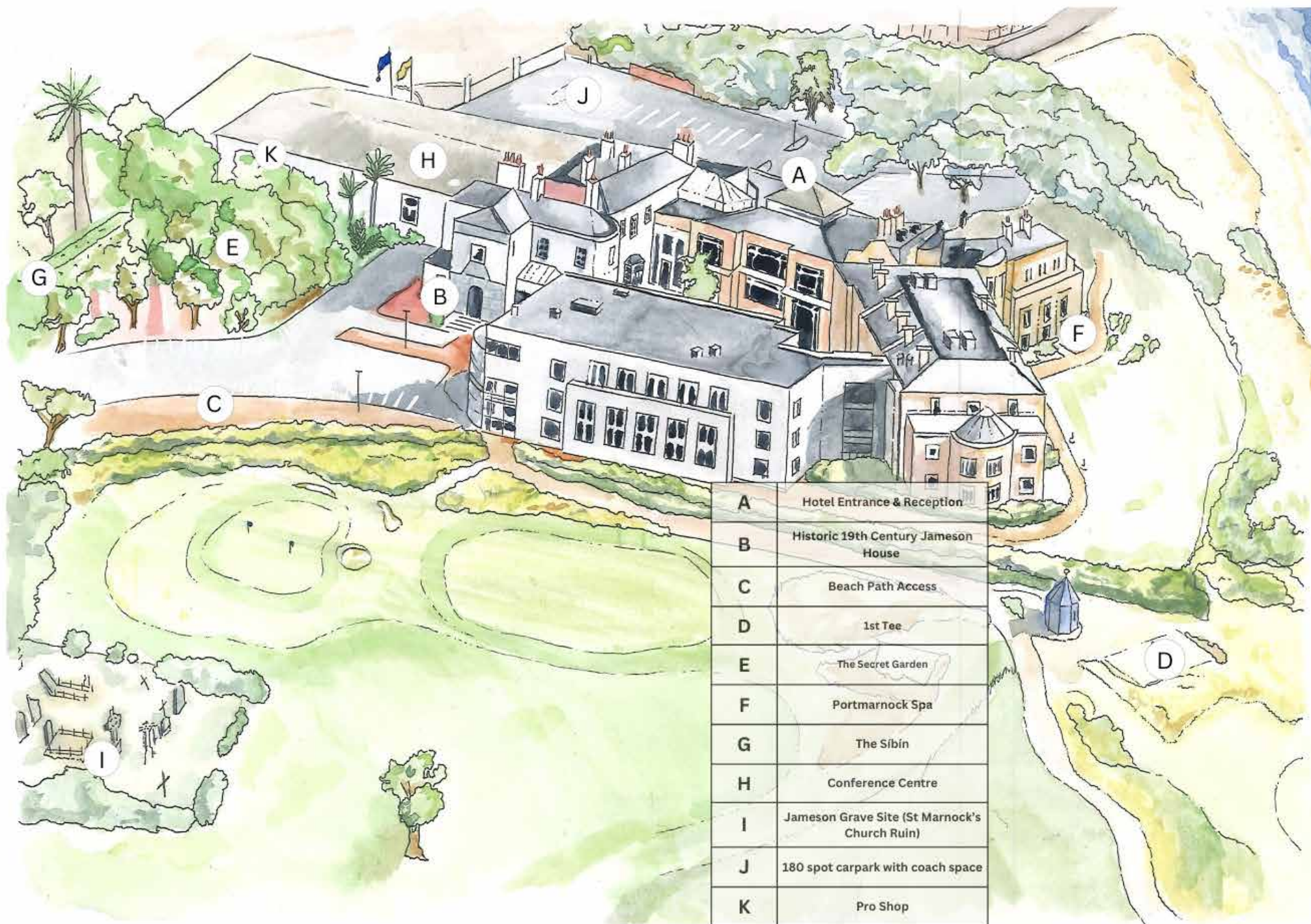

OUR AWARD-WINNING LINKS GOLF COURSE

Originally opened in 1995 and designed by golfing legend Bernhard Langer, our award-winning links course underwent a major transformation in 2023. Following a comprehensive renovation of its classic links terrain, the course was proudly rebranded as Jameson Golf Links, a tribute to the pioneering role the Jameson family played in introducing golf to Ireland.

Back in the 1850s, the Jamesons created a private links on this very stretch of coast. Nearly two centuries later, golfers still enjoy the same dramatic dunescape beside the iconic Velvet Strand.

Today, Jameson Golf Links is regarded as one of Ireland's premier modern links courses. With fast-running fescue fairways and traditional rivetted bunkers, it delivers a true test of skill for golfers of all levels. Along the way, players are treated to breathtaking coastal views of the Irish Sea, Ireland's Eye, and Lambay Island, making for an unforgettable seaside golfing experience.

The Jameson Experience – ‘Taste, Dine, Explore’

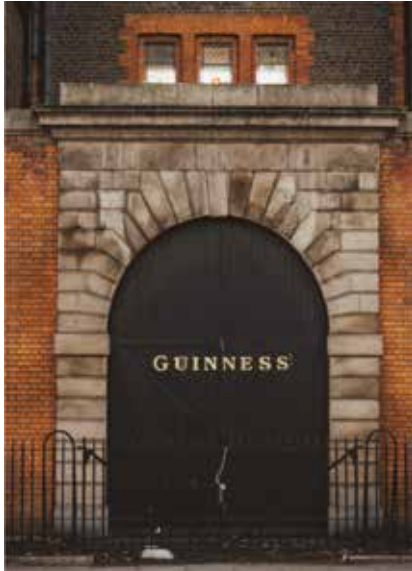

Phoenix Park

The Phoenix Park is one of the largest enclosed public parks in any capital city in Europe.

The park is home to the Phoenix Park Visitor Centre, Áras an Uachtaráin, Zoological Gardens, Victorian Flower Gardens, a Biodiversity Information Centre, Phoenix Café and Tea Rooms and a large herd of wild fallow deer. The Phoenix Park is open 24 hrs a day, 7 days a week, all year round.

Lambay Island

Just four miles off the coast of County Dublin lies Lambay Island, a hidden gem in the Irish Sea. Covering a square mile, it is the largest island off Ireland's east coast and the largest privately owned island in North-West Europe.

Lambay is home to a rich tapestry of wildlife, including birds, seals, fallow deer, and a now-thriving population of over 100 wild wallabies. First introduced in the 1950s and supplemented by Dublin Zoo in the 1980s, these marsupials are one of the island's most curious residents.

The island also holds deep historical significance. Ancient monastic ruins still stand today, bearing witness to Viking raids as early as the 8th century AD, making Lambay the first part of Dublin to be attacked during that era.

With its blend of fine architecture, natural beauty, and unique wildlife, Lambay offers a rare and unforgettable experience. Visits are strictly limited and available by private arrangement only between April and September. Tours include boat transfers from Malahide in the package. Crossings, which take around 20 minutes, are tide-dependent and organised by Lambay directly.

Ireland's Eye Ferries

Glendalough & Wicklow Mountains Half Day Tour

This half-day tour is a convenient way to experience the beauty of the Irish countryside without having to rent a car or waste precious hours in transit. Enjoy the scenery extended out before you embark on the journey from Dublin to County Wicklow and wander around Glendalough at a pace that suits you. Soak up views of Wicklow Mountains National Park during the drive. Hike around the monastic ruins of Glendalough at your leisure. See filming locations from films like 'Braveheart' and 'P.S. I Love You'. A choice of city centre departure spots makes for a stress-free experience.
